
CUFF BRACELET



1 spent an afternoon

cutting ImagiNiscE

"LIVE LOUD" Parpeirs

into strips and layering them to create this series of super deluxe cute outf bracelets!



Step 1.) Gather a Stack of paper to work with. Cut Strips long enough to fit the end weavers wrist and as wide as you'd like cuff to be. Because you'll want to layercut all different widths - but same lengths. 2.) Stack layers on top of each other, Attach w/ a glue stick. 3.) Make Several of these, all different, to create the base for several bracelets.

A.) hine all of the layered paper bracelet bases up in an 8/2 x 11 laminating Sheet. | _ laminating sheet Run all at once (Iwas able to fit 7) through t lower laminator of Your Story Machine. 5.) Once they are double sided laminated - cut them in Strips again. I used both straight edge and I used pinking sheeks to create some w/ pinkered edgs.

- 6.) How using the ImaginiscE itop i created magnet clasps and decorative brads and a couple of flowers w/ the itop punches.
- 7.) Follow the itop instructions to make different size magnets and brads Using the Same papers as the rest on your brace let bases. I used Imaginisce brace let bases. I used Imaginisce "Live Loud" papers.
- 8.) Also, I used the Itop flower looking punches to create layers.

 That I DIDN'T wrap around the branks.

| 10.) Now glue one magnet button you create to the end of each bracelet. end of each bracelet. I use E-GOO Glue to ensure the magnet will stay on forever. the magnet will stay on forever. (Follow their instructions) QK glue at end on each braclet. |
