
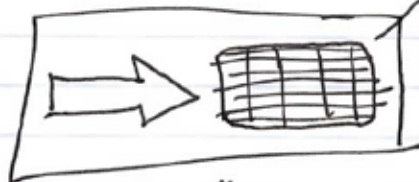
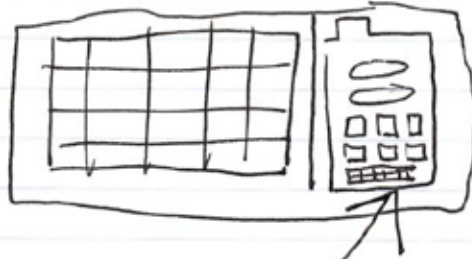

Arrow:

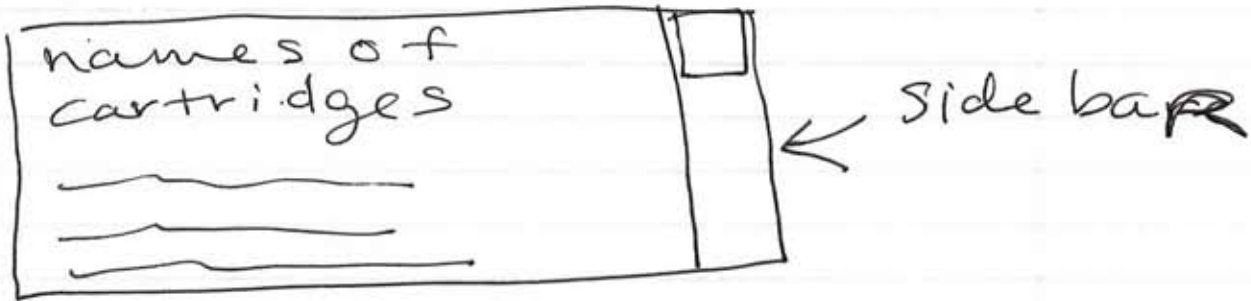

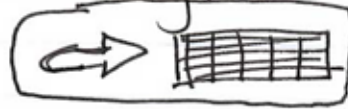

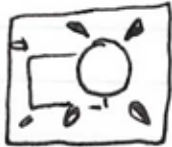
Now that you have selected all images you want to work w/

### NOTE:

Locate arrow on screen to MATCH MAT that will load into Cricut.

When you first go to the mat page the images will be "grouped" if you want to ungroup



click the "ungroup" button

TO ZOOM IN:

... click & hold upper top button



TAP on the screen wherever the image is at.

TO ZOOM OUT: just click that upper left button

## COLOR OF OUTLINE means:

When ~~it~~ is black it  
is not selected

When it's blue it is  
selected.

When it's red it's fused

When it's purple it is  
a seperate selection

To select just one of  
the images click on  
it or tap on it twice.

Now you can touch  
just the one image and  
drag to "top" of other  
image or sulch (remember the  
crown on the owl)

\* Be sure all images  
are grouped 3 that they  
are touching or overlapping

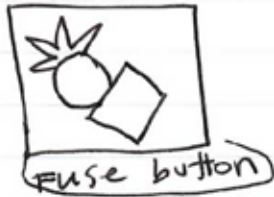
Keep ~~over~~ where it's crossing

how to fuse OR WELD continued . . .

With group selected (blue line)  
Click on "ADVANCED" tab  
in upper right (top) corner

click once



Outer square

~~will~~ will turn yellow and  
the star/circle/square <sup>shape</sup> will  
become pink & solid



A fused shape,  
when selected  
is blue - when unselected  
is RED

To check what "Fuse"  
will look like:

click on the eyeball  
button



Button turns  
yellow

red lines are CUT lines  
grey lines will NOT cut

Un-select the preview mode  
"eyeball"

- Button is no longer yellow

## TO CUT:

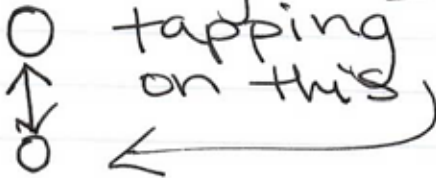
Click back over to the "BASIC" tab off of ADVANCED

this button

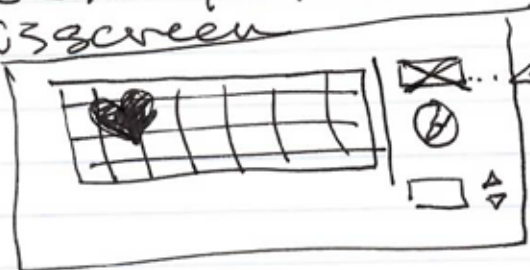

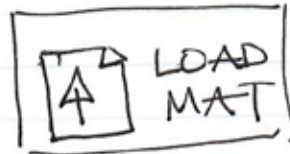

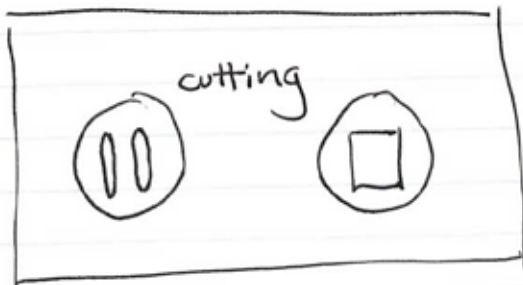

IN the Advanced tab setting. Make sure your shape is blue/selected


Click on the box →

in Advanced Tab

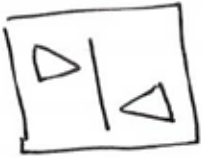
 - is space in between your shape

 - to rotate shapes

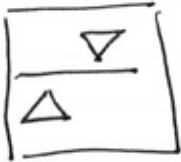
 - stretches the shape

- Fuses Shapes



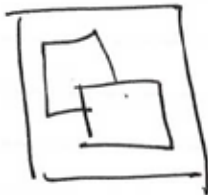
- Flips shapes

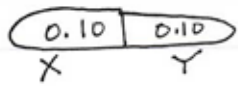

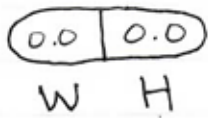

## BASIC Tab Menu

• inches



= Tap on these boxes to change where the image is located on the mat



= Tap on these boxes to change the width and height of the shape(s)

NOTE: Below this option is a chain link icon

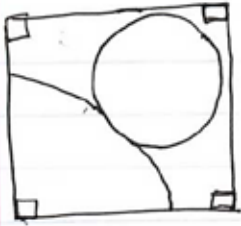


IF you want the height  $\approx$  width to resize the same make sure this icon is yellow.

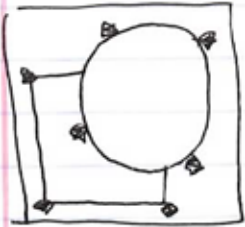
IF you want to change just the height or width deselect this icon so it is white.

Then as an example you could take a snow man and make him really fat or really tall  $\approx$  skinny.

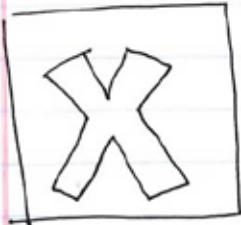
## Basic Tab Menu cont.



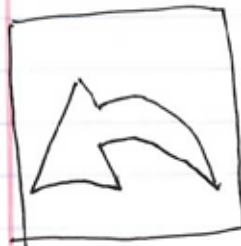
- Group Button  
tap on this to  
group shapes together  
(Yellow)  
or to turn this option  
off un-tap (white)



- Un group Button  
click on this to  
separate all the  
shapes into separate  
images



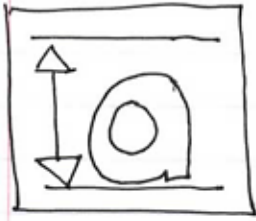
- Delete Button  
click on this to  
delete any shape,  
that is highlighted  
that you no longer want.



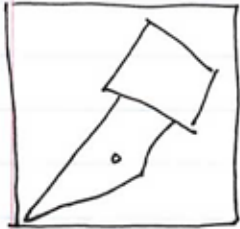
- Undo Button  
click on this to undo  
the last action that  
you just did - if you  
made a mistake



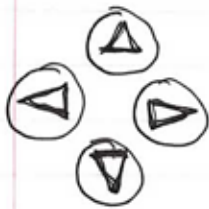
## Basic Tab MENU cont.



- True Size button  
click this (highlight it yellow) to put shape into relative size or key height character



- CUT Button  
click on this to begin the cutting process



- Navigation Arrows  
click on these in which ever direction you want to move your shape around on the mat



SIZE BUTTON  
click this to size the entire selected ~~shape~~ shape - up or down for larger or smaller
