


# Tea Towel Pillows



This is such a great, quick Sat. afternoon project. I collect cool tea towels whenever I find them. Anthropology is a great place to discover new ones!


- 1.) gather your tea towels and lay them out to determine what size pillow form you'll need.

2.) To do this - fold your towels in  $\frac{1}{2}$   measure the height & width.

\*Do not worry about the fattness of the pillow - we'll get to that.

3.) BUY or make a pillow form to fit.

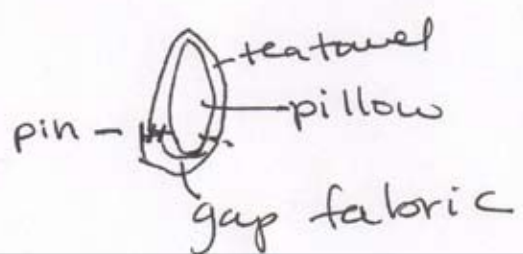
4.) wrap the towel in  $\frac{1}{2}$  around the pillow form.

You want to have  pillow a gap in fabric and not have it wrap all the way around.

5.) Measure the area that is the gap. Choose a Coordinating fabric in either a print or a solid. Ready this piece of fabric to be the gap fill in by ironing and sewing to size.

6.) Sew to ONE end of the Tea towel. ~~the~~

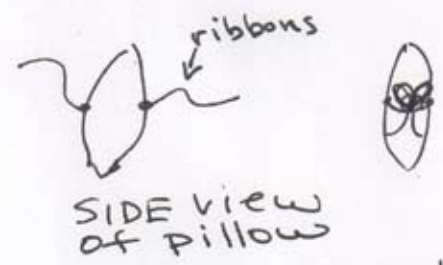
7.) Wrap around the pillow and pin gap fabric to the other end of the tea towel



8.) Slide the pillow out  
Sew 2<sup>nd</sup> end to tea towel. 4

Now feel free to "decorate"  
What will be the front  
of your pillow w/ trims  
and notions.

9.) For the final step - Cut  
4 ribbons 12 in. long and  
sew one to each side of  
the opening



You will use these to tie  
The tea towel "case" closed  
so it stays on the pillow.
